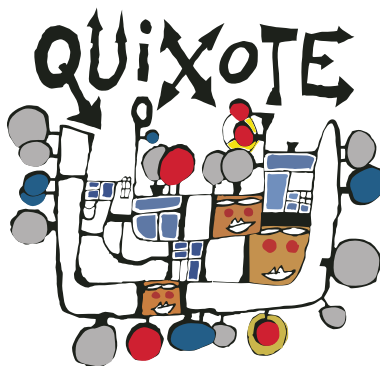




QUIXOTE 2021 PETITE SIRAH HELMET OF MAMBRINO

Quixote's top Petite is their 2021 Petite Sirah Helmet of Mambrino, which aged entirely in new French oak puncheons. Marked by classic aromas of blueberries and licorice, with just a hint of vanilla, it's full-bodied, concentrated and dense without being heavy; firm and muscular without being hard or tough, with a long finish that manages to be simultaneously dusty and mouthwatering. The alcohol is 15.74%, so this taster, for one, isn't entirely sure how it will age over the long term, but for fans of extreme Petite Sirahs, this is fun.
