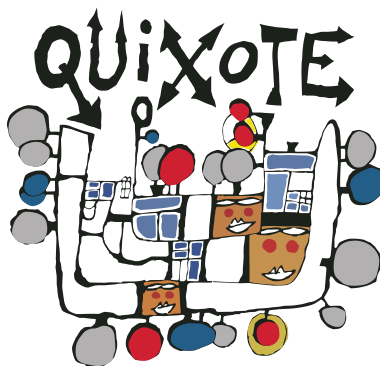




2021 QUIXOTE WINERY Petite Sirah

Reviewer's Comments: The 2021 Petite Sirah has an opaque purple-black color, offering up pronounced notes of tar, stewed black plums, and smoked meats, plus nuances of fruit cake and licorice. The full-bodied palate is rich and dense with black fruit preserves flavors, framed by firm, ripe, grainy tannins and just enough freshness, finishing with great length.
